



The **11th CACCI Local Chamber Awards** is one of the projects of the Confederation of Asia-Pacific Chambers of Commerce and Industry (CACCI). It seeks to recognize local chambers for their achievement in providing services to its members and to the community where its members operate. Presentation of the Awards shall be made during the Gala Dinner of the 40th CACCI Conference to be held in Manila in the latter part of 2026.

I. Objectives

The 11th CACCI Local Chamber Awards is intended to:

1. Encourage local chambers to strive for excellence in delivering services to their members by adopting useful and practical projects and programs to assist their constituencies;
2. Provide incentives to local chambers not only to render outstanding service to their community and to the business sector but also to help promote the economic development of the community and provide employment to the people;
3. Bring awareness of the CACCI Program to the grassroots, namely, to the local chambers and their members.

II. Categories

The Awards shall be given in two Categories:

Category 1: Big Local Chambers, defined as those chambers with membership of more than 200

Category 2: Small Local Chambers, defined as those chambers with membership of 200 or less

III. Criteria

The Awards in each category shall be determined by outstanding achievements in the following:

1. Outstanding Services to Own Members:

- a. Policy advocacy efforts made on behalf of the business community in their respective locality, and promotion of CACCI's own positions on policy issues (25%), and
- b. Successful training programs and seminars for members conducted on its own or in cooperation with other institutions, with the level of success to be measured by number of training programs or seminars conducted and size of participants (25%).

2. Outstanding Services to Community (and to country):

- a. Undertaking trade or investment promotion projects such as trade fairs, trade and investment missions, or other activities that have beneficial impact on the community's economy (25%).
- b. Initiating or pursuing projects that generate employment and services such as helping in preserving peace and order, urging local government or bringing to the attention of CACCI the need for specific measures to provide a favorable environment for investment in their respective localities, or motivating and assisting in the growth and development of SMEs and microenterprises (25%).

All entries shall be evaluated and assigned weighted grades on the basis of the above criteria, (see attached score card).

IV. Nominations and Judging

Nominations and Pre-Judging Evaluation:

1. The CACCI Local Chamber Awards is open to all Primary Members' affiliated local chambers of commerce and industry (town and city chambers). **Members must be up to date on their dues to be eligible to nominate.**
2. Qualified to participate are those nominated and endorsed by a Primary Member who shall select the two best entries under each category from among the local nominees, and submit these selected entries to the CACCI Secretariat.
3. The timeframe of achievements shall cover the period from January 2024 to December 2025.
4. The entries must be documented with a summary of not more than 1,000 words about the achievement of the Local Chamber nominee during the period. It should briefly state what has been achieved under each of the criteria, what were the objectives, and how were these objectives attained.
5. The Awards Committee shall be constituted from representatives of Primary Members who have not submitted any nominations and are willing to serve in the Committee. The Committee shall evaluate the nominations and make a short-list of the three best local chambers under each category. The short list shall, in turn, be passed on to the Board of Judges, composed of representatives of the Primary Members who are willing to serve as such, for final evaluation and judging.
6. The nominee must:

- Agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the CACCI Awards Committee and the Board of Judges;
- Be willing to give additional information required by the Committee and the Board of Judges;
- Have its Chamber President or his representative available to make a presentation or for interview, if required; and receive the Award, if selected.

Final Selection and Judging Process:

7. The short-listed nominees shall be evaluated by the Board of Judges using a weighted grading system. The Board's evaluation shall be made based on the supporting documents submitted by the nominees and through interviews of the nominees.
8. The nominee in each category that receives the highest weighted grade shall be declared the winner for that category.
9. The decisions of the Board of Judges shall be final.

V. Schedules for the 11th Local Chamber Awards

Jan 26, 2026	Sending of first circular to the Primary Members announcing of the Launching of the Awards Program and seeking nominations
Feb 27, 2026	Sending of second circular to the Primary Members on the 11 th CACCI Local Chamber Awards
Mar 31, 2026	Sending of third circular to the Primary Members on the 11 th CACCI Local Chamber Awards
Apr 30, 2026	Sending of fourth circular to the Primary Members on the 11 th CACCI Local Chamber Awards
May 31, 2026	Deadline of Submission of Nominations by Local Chambers to their Primary or National Chambers
Jul 17, 2026	Deadline for Submission by Primary Members of their two best nominees under each category to the CACCI Secretariat
Jul 24, 2026	Constitution of the Awards Committee
Jul 31, 2026	Secretariat submits nominees from Primary Members to the Awards Committee for evaluation and grading.
Aug 17, 2026	Selection of six short-listed nominees (three for each category) based on evaluation by the Awards Committee.
Aug 24, 2026	Constitution of the Board of Judges

Sept 4, 2026	Deadline for submission to the Board of Judges of the short-list together with supporting documents
Oct 1, 2026	Board of Judges conduct individual online interviews with short-listed candidates and selects winner
Oct 8, 2026	Announcement of winner
Nov, 2026 (tbc)	Presentation of Awards (Gala Dinner of the 40 th CACCI Conference)

VI. The Awards

1. The winners of the 11th CACCI Local Chamber Awards under Category 1 and Category 2 shall each receive a trophy plus US\$2,000 cash.
2. The winner or a duly authorized representative must receive the award and prizes in person during the Gala dinner of the 40th CACCI Conference in Manila, Philippines on November 2026 (tbc).
